Postgraduate Program Intelligence Management and Security



The program in Intelligence Management and Security seeks to respond, in an objective and informed way, to the challenges posed to various institutions within the framework of the current system of security, defense, international cooperation, and information culture in the global world. This course provides analytical skills and presents methodologies for assessing, managing and making decisions in complex international security and defense contexts, which require an understanding of the regional political, diplomatic, economic and social framework.

Goals

The goal of this program is to train technical staff and managers to:

- Obtain comprehensive skills in the various stages of the information production cycle;
- Understand, analyze, and research globalization processes;
- Demonstrate knowledge of intelligence and information gathering, and techniques of data analysis;
- Communicate complex issues, clearly and effectively;
- Promote key skills to support decision making, enhanced by the use of Competitive Intelligence and Business processes;
- Understand the role of strategic intelligence and the additional challenges posed by artificial intelligence.

Who is it for?

The program is aimed at undergraduates in any compatible field who wish to acquire skills related to security and strategic studies or update their knowledge and explore new perspectives, given the current theories and subjects.

Among the potential target of this postgraduate program, those who work in the fields of intelligence and security, in particular elements of the forces and security services, military, decision-making support and competitive intelligence managers, NGO technicians, other technicians of the public administration responsible for information management, stand out in the application process.

Study Plan

The curriculum of the postgraduate program consists of 8 mandatory course units, a total of 60 ECTS.
